Through collaboration with the **Canadian Optometric Education Trust Fund (COETF)**, the Canadian Association of Optometrists is pleased to offer funding to support the training of Indigenous people through the Canadian Certified Optometric Assistant program (CCOA).

Mentored by a **CAO member optometrist**, the successful candidate receives on-the-job training tailored to becoming an Optometric Assistant.

Funding includes:

- CCOA Program registration fee (value of \$1999)
- CCOA Workshop registration (value of \$500)
- Up to \$1000 for travel and accommodations to CCOA Workshop

Eligibility Criteria:

Applicants must be currently employed by a CAO member optometrist.

Applicants must identify as Métis, Inuit, or First Nations individuals and submit one of the following:

- Band membership card


