

APPLICATION FOR THE CCOA PROGRAM SCHOLARSHIP 2022-2023

First Nations and Inuit Youth Employment Strategy

Through the First Nations and Inuit Youth Employment Strategy (FNIYES), the Canadian Association of Optometrists is pleased to provide funding to facilitate the hiring and training of Indigenous youth as Certified Canadian Optometric Assistants (CCOA).

Mentored by a CAO member optometrist, successful candidates become fully salaried office team members and receive on-the-job training as trained and specialized Optometric Assistants.

Funding includes:

- » CCOA Program registration fee;
- » Wages* from September 4, 2023, to March 31, 2024. Employers can provide a higher hourly wage for enhanced retention;
- » Workshop registration, including travel and accommodations.

Candidates between the ages of 18 and 30, who meet any of the following criteria are eliqible to apply:

- 1 Resident on Reserve or in a Recognized Community on Crown land
 - » May be temporarily off reserve for the primary purpose of seeking education\employment.
- 2 Inuit Residents Outside Their Territory:
 - » Inuit individuals living in Canada who no longer qualify for funding from their territory.
 - » Proof of refusal from the territory is required to demonstrate eligibility.

CCOA Program end date: June 7, 2024
